Pichhwai paintings are big sized paintings done on cotton cloth using natural colors and are hung behind the idol of Lord Shrinath Ji to depict his leelas. It's been four generations of my family, we are doing this. All the colors are made by the artist themselves only; with the natural colors we also use natural gum to have durability of colors on the cloth for 300-400 years.
